Vision Board for your Landscape renovation

Take before pictures of the area you plan to renovate.

Measure the area of the new renovation.

Find landscape photos that include hardscape and softscape that you will use for the project. Plants which are water resistant, edible plants, walkways made with DG or rocks, synthetic turf and plants that are good for the environment and attract *beneficial* insects.

Put your ideas on a vision board or design on the computer.

To get your project started there are a few steps to remove the existing unwanted grass/turf, sod, and vegetation, checking the drainage, capping off the current sprinkler system and leveling off the surface. Yes, the area will look a little shabby while the prepping is taking place, but will be well worth it the saving in water and maintenance.


